## Rules & Regulations

### Code of conduct:

Competitor's/participants at any event run by NTQHA have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the NTQHA and the AQHA at all times. Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

**Important Information:** Competitors are required to be a member of the AQHA or an AQHA affiliated club to be covered by public liability insurance. Or pay a day membership to be covered.

All AQHA rules apply, including code of conduct and animal welfare rules. Amateur permits are to be provided for inspection on collection of competitor numbers.

### Venue Information

**Location:** Near Esk Lodge, Cook Street, Hadspen. Turn off the Meander Valley Hwy at Hadspen onto Bartley Street, follow Barley Street to the end, you will see the gateway into the property. Signs will be placed from the Meander Valley Hwy.

**Yards:** There are no fixed yards available at this venue, however plenty of room to erect your own, Competitors are asked to **PLEASE** ensure that their yards are left clear of hay and manure, your co-operation is appreciated.

**Canteen Facilities:** There are no Canteen facilities at this show. There are two BBQ area's one is covered with table and chairs the other is close to river access. There will be a fund raising sausage sizzle held on the Saturday night.

**First Aid Facilities:** Are available with the Show Secretary.

**STRICTLY NO DOGS PERMITTED AT THE GROUNDS.**

## Rules & Regulations Continued

**Competitor Numbers:** Are to be worn by all competitors. A \$2 deposit per horse for non NTQHA members is to be paid with entries and will be refunded on return of numbers at the conclusion of the show. Numbers for NTQHA members have been carried over from last season, replacement numbers are available for lost numbers at a cost of \$2 each.

**Protests:** All protests are to be lodged to the show committee together with a fee of \$20 within 15 minutes of the event. No liability will be accepted for the loss of or damage to animals, persons or property.

**Safety Helmets:** It is optional that an exhibitor may wear a safety helmet which conforms to the current Australian safety standards in all classes. However it is mandatory that all exhibitors wear such helmets in over fence classes and when schooling over fences. It is mandatory for all youth competitors to wear a helmet which conforms to the Australian safety standards when competing in all speed events. The chin strap must be securely fastened under the chin at all times during competition. Speed events are defined as events where speed is the determining factor and includes camp drafting, roping, barrel racing and pole bending.

**2 year old classes:** A 2 year old horse may only compete in either the 2 year old or Junior Horse class, not in both. A horse may compete in a 2 year old class from 1st January of it's 2 year old year.

**3 year old classes:** A 3 year old horse may only compete in either the 3 year old or Junior Horse class, not in both. A horse may compete in a 3 year old class from 1st August of it's 3 year old year.

### **Beginner Rider Rule:**

1. Beginner classes are Walk/Trot/Jog classes only and are intended to be an introduction to the basic western events for new riders or those new to western riding.
2. Equipment and attire to be safe, neat and tidy. A Beginner Rider may ride any horse in any approved western headgear. Bridled horses may be ridden two handed.
3. Beginner Riders may only compete in Beginner classes – as soon as they enter any Improver class or any other event that requires a lope/canter they are no longer eligible for Beginner.
4. At the end of each show season the Improver Committee will review the Beginner status of each rider. If the person is deemed to be ready to move up to Improver status they will be excluded from Beginner classes the following season.
5. Beginner classes will only be offered in Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Trail and Hunter Under Saddle.

### **Improver Rider Rule:**

1. Improver classes are intended to be an intermediate level between Beginner and Open, or, in certain circumstances, for riders returning to the sport after a lengthy break, injury or other approved reasons.
2. In an Improver Class equipment and attire to be safe, neat and tidy. An Improver Rider may ride any horse in any approved western headgear. Bridled horses may be ridden two handed, however if competitor starts a class one handed, they must continue one handed, i.e. they will be penalised if they "two hand" during that class. Similarly, if a class is started two handed the rider must continue two handed.
3. Improvers may enter \*open performance classes, ie classes which are recognised by the AQHA, AAA or PHAA as point scoring however one win in an open performance event, regardless of the number of competitors, and they will not be eligible for that event as an improver at the completion of the show. For example – if the rider wins a 3yo Western Pleasure (even as the only competitor) they will no longer be eligible for Improver Western Pleasure at the end of the show.

Note: Improver riders need to consider whether they wish to jeopardise their Improver status by entering open performance events. To further clarify – an OPEN event is one for which the AQHA, AAA or PHAA will award points (including Amateur classes) – as an example an OPEN or ALL AGE Western Horsemanship class is not allocated points by the AQHA but is by the AAA therefore a win in this class (regardless of which association you are registered with) will put you out of Improver Western Horsemanship. Improver status is not affected by wins in Halter, Amateur Halter, Yearling Led Trail, Lunge line or Hunter In Hand (any age).

4. Improver events to be offered in all events except Western Riding.
5. Any competitor wishing to regain Improver status due to circumstances described above in (1) must apply in writing via their own club to the Improver Committee.
6. The Improver Committee shall be made up of the Presidents of the STQHA, NTQHA, NWQHA. TAC and PPHAT at the time.

**ALL COMPETITORS AGREE TO COMPLY WITH ANY DIRECTIONS OF SHOW MANAGEMENT MADE IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY. ENTRY TO GROUNDS WILL BE DEEMED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES.**

Under the provisions of the Trade Practices Act and Various State Laws conditions are implied into contracts that mean that the Provider of Recreational Services, noted below, is required to ensure that the Recreational Services it sells to you are: rendered with due care and skill, are fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances or might reasonably be expected to achieve the result you have made known to the Provider.
