Rules & Regulations

THIS IS AN "A" APPROVED SHOW AND IS RUN UNDER CURRENT AQHA RULES. AQHA Membership and Registration numbers must be noted on Entry Forms for results to be sent to AQHA.

Important Information: All horses, Owners, Riders & Exhibitors must be current financial members of the AQHA in their own right. Memberships & registrations will be verified with the AQHA once entries are received. All AQHA rules apply, including code of conduct and animal welfare rules. Amateur permits are to be provided for inspection upon request.

TRAINING EQUIPMENT: At all AQHA approved shows there will be no training equipment allowed in the immediate marshalling area and the performance arena from one hour before the nominated commencement time of the show to **ONE HOUR AFTER** the cessation of events on each day.

MARSHALLING AREA: This is for competitors and Show Officials only. No spectators allowed. **THERE IS NO ALCOHOL TO BE TAKEN INTO OR CONSUMED IN THE MARSHALLING AREA AND/OR SHOW ARENA.**

No unauthorised entry allowed into the trail area once obstacles are positioned before or during the show.

REFUNDS will only be given if a vet certificate is received prior to the commencement of the show.

LEAD LINE: Approved safety helmets must be worn. Age 3-8 years

Competitor Numbers: Are to be worn by all competitors. These will be issued at the start of the season and should be kept by competitor. Replacement numbers can be issued at a cost of \$10.00 per set.

Protests: All protests are to be lodged to the show committee together with a fee of \$50.00 within 15 minutes of the event.

Safety Helmets: *It is optional that an exhibitor may wear a safety helmet which conforms to the correct Australian safety standards in all classes.*

First Aid Facilities: Are available with the Show Secretary.

Entries Close: Postmarked 30th January, 2012

However..... If any late entries are to be included (subject to committee approval) these will incur double entry fees and will **ONLY** be accepted prior to the 3rd February.

Any fees owing before the commencement of the show will result in that competitor being denied entry to the arena.

ALL COMPETITORS AGREE TO COMPLY WITH ANY DIRECTIONS OF SHOW MANAGEMENT MADE IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY. ENTRY TO GROUNDS WILL BE DEEMED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES.

STRICTLY NO DOGE PERMITTED AT THE GROUNDS.

Rules & Regulations

BEGINNER RIDER RULE:

1. Beginner classes are Walk/Trot/Jog classes only and are intended to be an introduction to the basic western events for new riders or those new to western riding.
2. Equipment and attire to be safe, neat and tidy. A Beginner Rider may ride any horse in any approved western headgear. Bridled horses may be ridden two handed.
3. Beginner Riders may only compete in Beginner classes – as soon as they enter any Improver class or any other event that requires a lope/canter they are no longer eligible for Beginner.
4. At the end of each show season the Improver Committee will review the Beginner status of each rider. If the person is deemed to be ready to move up to Improver status they will be excluded from Beginner classes the following season.
5. Beginner classes will only be offered in Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Trail and Hunter Under Saddle.

IMPROVER RULE:

1. Improver classes are intended to be an intermediate level between Beginner and Open, or, in certain circumstances, for riders returning to the sport after a lengthy break, injury or other approved reasons.
2. In an Improver Class equipment and attire to be safe, neat and tidy. An Improver Rider may ride any horse in any approved western headgear. Bridled horses may be ridden two handed, however if competitor starts a class one handed, they must continue one handed, ie they will be penalised if they “two hand” during that class. Similarly, if a class is started two handed the rider must continue two handed.
3. Improvers may enter open performance classes, ie classes which are recognised by the AQHA, AAA or PHAA as point scoring, however, one win in an open performance event, regardless of the number of competitors, and they will not be eligible for that event as an improver at the completion of the show. For example – if the rider wins a 3yo Western Pleasure (even as the only competitor) they will no longer be eligible for Improver Western Pleasure at the end of the show.

Note: Improver riders need to consider whether they wish to jeopardise their Improver status by entering open performance events. To further clarify – an OPEN event is one for which the AQHA, AAA or PHAA will award points – as an example an OPEN or ALL AGE Western Horsemanship class is not allocated points by the AQHA but is by the AAA therefore a win in this class (regardless of which association you are registered with) will put you out of Improver Western Horsemanship. Improver status is not affected by wins in Halter, Amateur Halter, Yearling Led Trail, Lunge line or Hunter In Hand (any age).

4. Improver events to be offered in all events except Western Riding.
5. Any competitor wishing to regain Improver status due to circumstances described above in (1) must apply in writing via their own club to the Improver Committee.
6. The Improver Committee shall be made up of the Presidents of the STQHA, NTQHA, NWQHA. TAC and PPHAT at the time.
