

The Western Riding Championship of Tasmania

Rick and Vanessa Fulton will again sponsor the Western Riding Championship of Tasmania in conjunction with the Goulburn Valley Reining Horse Association – Tasmanian Division (GVRHA-TD).

The Western Riding Championship of Tasmania

will continue to award those riders competing in the two events that represent the pinnacle of non-cow western style riding, **Reining** and **Western Riding**.

How do I enter?

To Qualify for the award you just need to enter the right type of class at a minimum number of shows and classes as outlined below:

- Enter any of Junior, Senior, All Age or Open Reining and/or Western Riding classes at a minimum of **TWO** Western Breed Shows*, and;
(* NTQHA, STQHA, NWTQHA, TAC, PPHAT, not including State Shows),
- Enter any of Rookie, Intermediate, Novice or Open reining classes at any **TWO** GVRHA – TD Shows, and;
- Enter a minimum of 10 approved classes across the season.

You don't need to do anything extra!!

The Clubs will be asked to forward the results of those classes so they can be used to calculate the best average for each rider.

How will it be calculated?

Every Time you show in one of these classes you will be awarded points based on how many were in the class. That is:

The winner will be the rider with the highest average.

What do I need to do?

Enter as many reining or western riding classes as you can, have fun and see if you are the best Western Rider in Tasmania.

If you are you will be recognised with a Montana Silversmith's Buckle which is the **richest prize** in the Western horse field in Tasmania.
